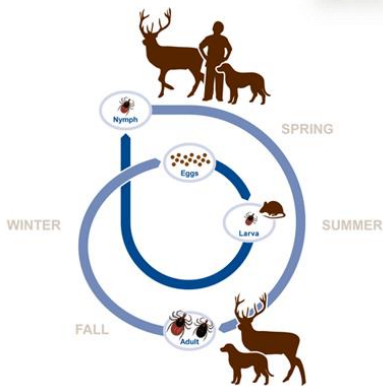

Blacklegged Tick Life Cycle



The average number of months per year that **dogs are at risk for tick exposure**, according to the majority of Canadian Veterinarians surveyed.



Average number of months per year pet parents reported **treating their dog for ticks**.

Fall is a peak activity time for adult blacklegged ticks. These ticks are responsible for **spreading Lyme disease**. A carrier tick could come into your house on your **dog's fur** and get on you.
